FOREIGN POLICY

OFTEN WE ONLY THINK OF STATE-TO-STATE ISSUES AND FOCUS ON SECURITY, NARROWLY DEFINED -- the physical survival of the United States and its people by protecting from attacks by states and non-states who intend to harm us.

THERE IS A BROADER DEFINITION OF SECURITY -- the physical survival and safety of the United States and its people by protecting from all physical threats. (Think Harvey and Houston, Sea Rise, and Pandemics)

THERE ARE ALSO TWO OTHER CORE NATIONAL INTERESTS: HUMAN DEVELOPMENT AND SURVIVAL OF POLITICAL AND CULTURAL VALUES.

MOREOVER, INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS INVOLVE MORE THAN STATE-TO-STATE RELATIONS. THERE ARE MANY OTHER PLAYERS IN THE WORLD.
