Three Tiers

A way to view development. Not a value judgement. Not a causal statement or relationship.

First - all of the below:

an effective government integrated into the world economy integrated into the world politically preference for orderly change no violent internal conflict

Third – generally, probably failed states

an ineffective government weak economy that is not well integrated into the world economy weak external relations preference, perhaps, for radical change violent internal conflict

Second -

transitional upwards – uneven or incomplete trend toward first tier characteristics

mired or transitional downward – closer to third tier in characteristics or trend toward those characteristics
