

WHY THE USSR COLLAPSED

*Remember that the USSR is NOT Russia; Russia was 1 of 15 Republics within the United Soviet Socialist Republic

I. <u>Internal Soviet Instability</u>

- 1. General Economic Failure
 - a. USSR could not compete in the World economy
 - b. There was a continuous drain of resources to the military and Cold War policies
 - c. Inadequate supply of resources for its people
 - d. Lagged technologically behind all others
- 2. Political Institutional Failure
 - a. Central communism did not work for all of the republics
 - b. It was not able to meet the needs of all of its people
 - c. Corruption and inability to change
- 3. Republics want Autonomy 1990 (Nationalism moving force)
- 4. Baltic States (Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania) gain Independence 1991
- 5. Gorbachev plans to Restructure the USSR *August 1991*
- 6. Party Coup Fails 21 August 1991

II. <u>Internal Soviet Political Activity</u>

1. Ukraine / Kravchuk

17 March 1991 Sovereignty Referendum

24 August 1991 Declaration of Independence by Parliament

- 2. Gorbachev steps down as General Secretary of the CPSU *24 August 1991* Power transfers completely to Yeltsin
- 3. Ukraine, Russia, and Belarus plan to dissolve the USSR *8 December 1991* 25 December 1991 USSR ceased to exist; new governments in 15 individual states because active (only 24 years ago).
