ETHNICITY & IDENTITY

IDENTITY – A SENSE OF WHO I AM

DERIVED FROM – SOCIALIZATION PROCESS IN A COMMUNITY

THUS: IDENTITY – A SENSE OF BELONGING

ETHNICITY – ETHNIC COMMUNITY IDENTITY

significantly different from others in terms of cultural (dialect, religion, traditions, etc.) and sometimes physical characteristics (skin color, body shape, etc.)

The two general ways in which individuals acquire their ethnic identity:.

- 1) self-identification
- 2) imposition by others

NEUTRAL OR NOT NEUTRAL?

ETHNOCENTRISM

the feeling that your own group's cultural traditions and values are correct and superior to all others

or a response to a dominant ethnic group or used by leaders

To provide political independence, distributive justice

consolidation, mobilization, goal seeking

THUS:

Ethnicity - groups - nationalism - state

OR

same pattern to destruction of current state and creation of new states

issues: intense ethnic feeling - ethnic violence - ethnic cleaning and failed states
